Location	<p>Little Feet Forest School summer camps will take place in our local National Forest Lands. These trailheads are easily accessible from Brook Forest Rd. and are roughly a 15-minute drive from the center of Evergreen.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Days 1-2 (Mondays & Tuesdays)- Cub Creek Trail, Shadow Mountain • Days 3-4 (Wednesday & Thursday)- Upper Maxwell Falls, Shadow Mountain
Facilities	<p>The trail sites that will host our camps have no additional services or facilities, this includes restrooms. All materials, safety equipment, and personal items will be carried in/out by staff and participants. Participants need to feel comfortable going to the bathroom outside, with the assistance of a licensed adult (if needed), because there are no restroom facilities.</p>
Times	<p>8:30 AM-2:00 PM***(camp will end at 2:00 PM each day to avoid afternoon thunderstorms for the safety of our participants) 8:30-9:00 AM- flexible drop-off; 1:45-2:00 flexible pick-up</p>
Group Details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 participants • 2 forest school facilitators + additional volunteers
Snacks/Lunch	<p>Two healthy snacks will be provided to all participants throughout the day; snacks consist of fruits and/or vegetables and at least one other food group. Allergies will be taken into consideration. If your child is a big snacker, we suggest packing additional snacks.</p> <p>All participants need to bring their lunch.</p>

What to Pack?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A small backpack that the child can carry • Rain gear • Sunscreen • Change of clothes (in case of an accident or clothing gets wet) • Water bottle • Sunglasses and/or hat for sun protection • Lunch • Participants should wear clothing that can get dirty!
Participant Abilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carry a small bag with personal items • Walk .3 of a mile • Potty trained; willing to go to the bathroom outside with the assistance of staff (if needed) • Ability to be outside for extended amount of time • Communicate needs to staff • Play/collaborate with other children
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Storytelling, songs, and kid’s yoga • Bug study- games, catching, identification, art • Nature play: water play, games, building with natural materials, etc. • Art Journals • Hike • Fort building • Hammock calm area • Animal theater • And more...!
“Leave No Trace” Practices	Little Feet Forest School staff and participants practice “Leave no trace” principles. All materials we pack in will be packed out, waste properly disposed of, and clean-up completed collaboratively at the end of each day.
Transportation	<p>All families are responsible for the transportation of their participants to and from the trail. Drop-off/pick-up lists are included in the enrollment information.</p> <p>In the case of a medical emergency, emergency transportation will be called.</p>
Cost	<p>-\$345 per session (each week)</p> <p>-\$675 both sessions</p> <p>-10% discount for siblings</p>
